



Our „GREENLINE“ fabric collection consists of upholstery fabrics made from recycled polyester. The recycled polyester is recovered from 100% packaging materials. The material is collected and separated from any extraneous material, such as lids or labels. The material is then shredded to create granulate, melted and drawn into threads. Traceability, transparency and certifiable sustainability are in the DNA of the recycled material.

High-quality upholstery fabrics are then woven from the polyester threads. Using the example of upholstery fabrics made from 100% PET bottles, one sofa is equivalent to approximately *850 PET bottles in the form of recycled polyester. You can find more information in the enclosed fabric guide.

Cleaning and care

We recommend vacuuming upholstery with an upholstery nozzle as required. Avoid direct sunlight and placement close to a radiator or fireplace.

Food residues and liquids can be removed with a dry, absorbent cloth. When removing stains, work from the outside inwards. After treatment, leave the cleaned surface to dry unencumbered. Under no circumstances should acetone-based solvents or cleaning surfactants be used to remove stains.
